Project Veritas, in just the past five years, has produced work that has led to Congressional votes to defund National Public Radio; has instigated Medicaid investigations in Ohio & Virginia; caused Congress to defund the multi-billion dollar a year community action organization ACORN; forced several states to implement Voter ID laws; exposed fraud and abuse in the Department of Veterans Affairs; instigated positive legislative hearings and praise of our 2012 voter fraud expose in New Hampshire; allowed us to revisit NH and show voter fraud in 2016; and exposed for all to see how ridiculous our college campuses have become in their pursuit of political correctness.

Project Veritas' work has been done by a very small staff and we are now in a position to grow.

**This is not a role for the faint of heart.** Our journalists play a key role in an organization frequently attacked by big government-types. Your actions as an employee of Project Veritas will face public scrutiny by ideological organizations and individuals that may last indefinitely on the Internet and elsewhere. **The ideal candidate will not be deterred by this;** rather, he/she will be energized by the challenge.
